

MK Pro Initial Windows Setup

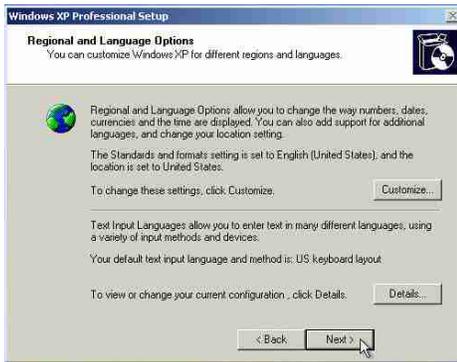
The following steps are required to initialize the Windows XP that is installed on the MK Pro. After the software has been initialized, you have 30 days to activate the copy of Windows XP on the system. After the 30 days the software must be activated in order to use the system. There are 2 ways to activate the copy of Windows, either through the internet or over the phone.

License Agreement

You are required to accept the Microsoft License Agreement. Click **Next**

Regional Language Settings

Windows XP restarts and then continues with the installation process. From this point forward, you can use your mouse. Eventually, the **Regional and Language Options** page appears. Click **Next** to accept the default settings



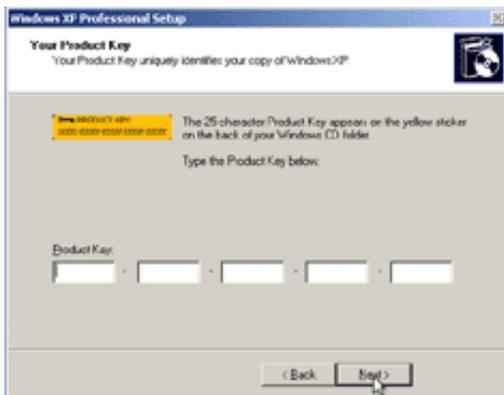
Personalize Your Software

On the **Personalize Your Software** page, type your name and your organization name. Some programs use this information to automatically fill in your name when required. Press **Next**.

Note: A name must be entered before you can go on.

Product Key

You do not need to enter in the product key information here. The Product key has been entered in at the factory and will be applied during Activation of Windows. Press **Next**.



Do you want to enter Product Key Now? Select **No**.



Computer Name and Administrator Password

On the **Computer Name and Administrator Password** page, in the Computer name box, a default computer name has been entered. You may change the name to another unique name that identifies the computer in use, such as LINE1 or ALPHALINE. You cannot use spaces or punctuation. If you connect your computer to a network, you will use this computer name to find shared files. If a Administrator is to be used, type a password that you can remember in the **Administrator password** box, and then retype it in the **Confirm password** box. Write the password down and store it in a secure place. Click **Next**. The Administrator password can be left blank.

Date and Time Settings

On the **Date and Time Settings** page, set your Then, click the **Time Zone** down arrow, and select Click **Next**.

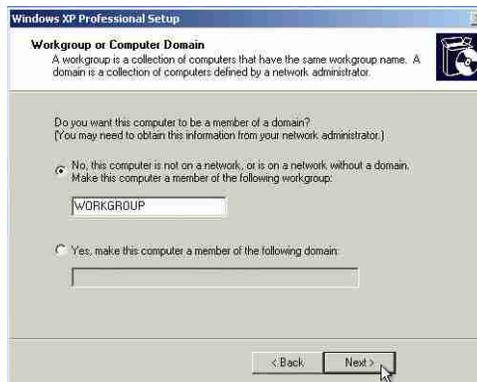

Network Settings

Windows XP will spend about a minute configuring the **Networking Settings** Select **Typical** Next.

If a workgroup is not needed, Select **No**, click **Next**.

Completing the Windows setup Wizard

Windows XP will spend about a minute configuring your computer, when done select **Finish** then Windows will automatically reboot.

This completes the Windows Setup.

Activating Windows

Windows provides a 30 day grace period from the time that Windows was setup until it must be activated. There are two ways to activate windows, through the Internet or over the phone. Using the internet is the quickest and easiest. To do this you will need to have an internet connection. Activation over the phone will take about 6 minutes.

Use the **Start menu**, select Activate Windows



Entering your Product Key

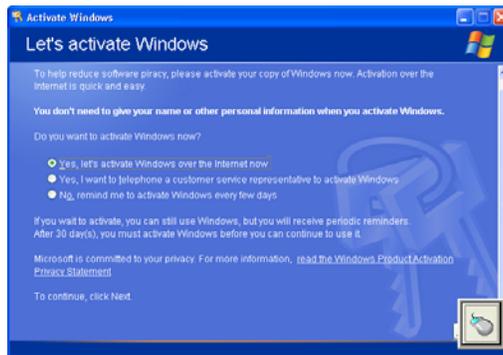
The window should open up with the assigned product key entered in, this was done during the manufacturing of the controller. Simply click **Update**.

If the fields are blank, you will need to enter in the Product Key information. To locate the Product Key numbers, **Remove all power** from the controller and open the controller door. The Product Key is located on the inside bottom, left corner.

Internet Activation

If you have access to a network the Internet, select this option and **Next**.

The system will connect to the Internet, software. At that point you have successfully windows.

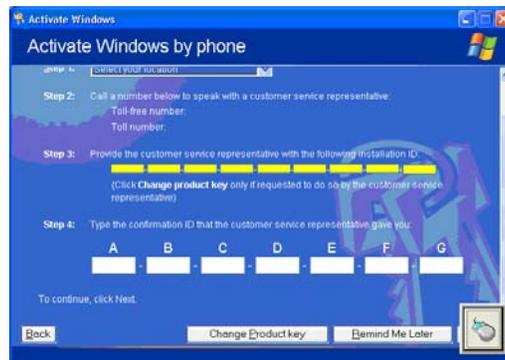
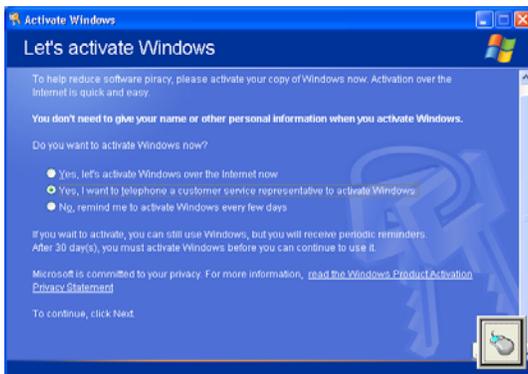

Phone Activation

Select **Yes** for the phone option and then **Next**.



Select a country, and dial the phone number provide to start the activation process. You will be asked to provide the installation ID number shown to the representative. They in turn will provide you with an installation ID number to input into the software. Once the number has been entered in correctly, select **Next**.

Windows will complete the activation process and you are done.

Changing Product Key Number

There may be a time that the Product be changed. Select this option and enter in the Key number. All controllers have a Windows XP sticker located on the inside of the case on the Make sure to remove power from the controller accessing the Product ID.
